Evolution of the Golf Course

2023 - Special Report on Course Changes to Date

Over the years, Camelot has made many tweaks to the golf course but the Club has retained the original corridors and green locations of the McBroom design. Below is a table which outlines for each hole the significant design changes by year as of the end of 2023. At the end is a section on changes to the practice areas. There have been changes to the course almost every year but there are several initiatives of particular note.

From the first year, Camelot has been installing and upgrading drainage improvements. These improvements substantially impact playability but not the course design itself. These changes will not be included in the table.

In 1995, the Club planted approximately 10,000 small trees, mainly white pines and spruces, around the perimeter of the course and between the 9th and 10th fairways. These trees were planted to provide visual and sound protection to the course and not to be part of play so they will not be referenced in the table. However, several hundred of these trees were replanted in later years to impact play and these are referenced.

The Club has been clearing trees, deadfall and brush from the start. Initially, much of the clearing was of deadfall from forested areas. Then it involved clearing underbrush in forested areas to improve playability and removing trees either due to disease or to open vista to improve sunlight or view plains. In May 2022, as the result of severe storm, 200+ trees fell or were damaged. Only clearing which significantly impacted playability will be included in the table.

In 2012, Camelot renovated all of its bunkers. One objective was to reduce the use of "shadow" pot bunkers and create a more "parkland" look. Most bunkers were left in place but expanded and lifted by reshaping into slopes. Bunkers changes that were this style of renovation without other changes are not referenced in the table. However, bunker additions and deletions over time will be referenced.

From 2018 through 2023, Camelot reconstructed and resurfaced all greens except #18 which had been reconstructed in 2006. Each green was surfaced with Triple 7 Bent Grass, the greens were expanded back to their original footprint and greens and surrounds were reshaped to improve runoff and eliminate "bird baths" that had built up over time. The specifics of each green renovation will only will be referenced in the table when the green design was significantly changed from the original.

From the opening of the course, Camelot has been installing new tee decks, mainly to lengthen the course and to expand decks on par 3s. These changes are referenced. Starting in 2022, the Club has a program to gradually resurface existing tee decks; changes will only be referenced if decks are significantly altered.

The Practice Area

1995 - Installation of fixed synthetic tee area at the back of the practice deck.

2003 – Closed tee deck in September; replaced two level tee deck with single layer deck of 41,600 sq. ft (an expansion of 27%); synthetic practice tees moved to back of new deck; deck seeded.

2004 – Deck open in June. Range closed in September to undertake major renovation of the landing area; landing area seeded with blue grass.

2005 - Renovated range opened in late June.

2006 – Range closed in September; minor modification to practice deck; synthetic practice tees removed; landing area reshaped and improved drainage installed; chipping green and bunkers/green practice area constructed.

2007 - New practice area opened in early July

2020 - Synthetic tee area installed at back of the tee deck.

2023 – Practice green closed at start of year; new green increased from 5,500 to 12,000 sq.ft., reconstructed and seeded. Opens in August.
